

<u>Gospel of the Lord</u> <u>Luke 10:29-37</u>


A man once said to Jesus 'I know that I should love God with all my heart, and love my neighbour too. But who is my neighbour?'

Then Jesus told him this story:

One day a man was travelling from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead. A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. A short time later another traveller came and saw him, but he too passed by on the other side. Then a Samaritan happen to pass and when he saw him, he took pity on him. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him. When the time came to leave, the Samaritan left the innkeeper enough money for the man's room until he was better.' Jesus then asked the man 'Which man in the story was a good neighbour?' 'The one who helped the wounded traveller', he answered. 'Go then and do the same for anyone who needs your help,' Said Jesus.
