## Nursery Parent Planning Week Beginning 9th December 2019

The children have been learning about the Christmas story. The have acted out the story this week and will be watching the Reception Nativity next week.

The children in Nursery have been really creative this week by finishing their salt dough decorations, designing their own Christmas crown and making a Christmas card. They will be wearing their Christmas crowns next week during the concert. They will also be hanging their salt dough decoration on the class Christmas tree during the performances on Thursday.

Next week we will also be talking about children that are not as fortunate as us. We will be thinking about presents that other children may like for Christmas and we will be sending our ideas to Father Christmas. The children will be drawing a picture of their idea and posting it in our classroom post box. We will be talking about the importance of sharing and thinking of other people.

#### Maths

The children will be continuing to learn about shapes and their properties. They will be wrapping up presents which will be different shapes and sizes to put under our class Christmas tree. This is a good opportunity for the children to develop their fine motor skills and practise their scissor skills.

At home: Get your child to wrap up junk modelling materials such as cereal boxes, cartons and kitchen tubes. They could use wrapping paper or design their own wrapping paper by drawing or printing on paper. They could also help you wrap up some real Christmas presents.
