THE LONDON AND SLOUGH RUN HOMELESS CHARITY are happy to have been granted rent free premises at Dukes House in Slough. This will allow the group to expand it's service collecting surplus food from local supermarkets for distribution locally to the homeless, local Charities and vulnerable groups. This is a 364 day a year operation and a large bank of volunteers will be required to sustain the project. Full training will be given and you can choose to do as few or as many shifts as you wish. The shifts and volunteer requirements are as follows: Monday to Friday 21.45 to 22.45. Saturday 20.30 to 22.00. Sunday 15.45 to 18.00. On each shift there is a requirement for minimum of 3 x sorters and re-packers and 1 x loader for carrying trays therefore ideally someone fit and Strong. There is also a requirement for volunteer drivers to collect and deliver food. The Driver Shifts will be: Evening 19:30 - 22:00 Morning 7:00 to 8:30. Access to Dukes house is at the top of the Queensmere centre by the Security office which is manned 24/7.
