The teaching staffing structure with effect from September 2017 is as follows:

Most of the children in the school had the opportunity to meet their new teacher this afternoon Tuesday 11th July. Mr Wall's did not meet their new teacher and unfortunately, Mr O'Keeffe had previous commitments with his current school so he will meet his new class on the afternoon of Monday 17th July.

Mr Wall's class- regrettably, we have not been successful in recruiting a teacher for this class. As you may be aware from the media, the recruitment of teachers is at a critical point in the country and all local schools are having great difficulty in recruiting good quality teachers. As a school we pride ourselves by ensuring that high quality teaching and learning is a focus in the school and we endeavour to recruit candidates of the highest quality. However, I am pleased to inform you that the school is actively interviewing candidates this week and next and will inform children and parents once we have been successful in recruiting for this position.

All KS1(Year 1 & Year 2) teachers except for Miss Rogan will be available to introduce themselves to parents on Wednesday 12th July between 6-7pm. Please note that Miss Rogan will be available to introduce herself to parents on **Thursday 13th July between 6.00-7.00pm.**

Thursday 13th July-KS2 appointments to discuss concerns on reports, appointments should be made in advance (3.30-5.00pm)

All KS2 teachers will be available to introduce themselves to parents on Thursday 13th July, except Mr O'Keeffe who will be available on Monday 17th July between 6.00-7.00pm. When we have recruited for Mr Wall's current class, those parents will be advised of a date they can meet the new teacher.

We would like to inform the parents of the current year 2 pupils and all other classes, that the children will remain in the same classes as they progress into their new class. The classes will not be mixed after very careful consideration.

New Year 3 children- On the first day back to school, parents are welcome to assort their child into the hall from 8.45am – 8.55am where the children will be welcomed by their new teacher. Year 3 will also be dismissed at 3.00pm instead of 3.15 for the first 3 days (Wednesday Sept 6th – Friday 8th Sept) back to school to help with the transition.
