The total number of questionnaires returned was 203 in total which is approximately a third of the total number of children attending this school.


The questionnaires overall results were very positive and as a school community we should celebrate and recognise this.




1. My child enjoys school






2. My child is encouraged to work hard to achieve their best






3. Our school keeps my child safe and is well cared for






4. Our school promotes positive behaviour. Inappropriate behaviour is dealt with effectively following the school Anti Bullying and behaviour policy.




5. I feel welcome when I come to visit the school






6. I am kept well informed about my child's progress through parent evenings and the end of year reports.






7. I feel comfortable about approaching the school with questions, a problem or a complaint.






8. Our school is led and managed well






9. I know who is on the Governing Body and their role within the school






10. Our school communicates effectively with parents using a variety of meanswebsite, newsletter, emails, texts, parent meetings, parent workshops






11. Our school provides appropriate homework






12. I feel the staff develop my child's self-esteem and independence






13. Our school promotes pupils' spiritual, moral and cultural development






14. There is a good range of activities that my child finds enjoyable (including extra-curricular clubs)






15. Our school helps my child to understand what constitutes to a healthy lifestyle.
