# **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2019**

If your child is in Year 3, and you wish your child to receive their First Holy Communion in May 2019 you will need to enrol them on the First Holy Communion programme. The First Holy Communion classes will begin in January 2019 and will be held at St Andrew's on Saturday mornings. The first enrolment date will be on **Wednesday**, **10**<sup>th</sup> **October** between 3.30pm and 5.00pm, the second enrolment date will be **Tuesday**, **16**<sup>th</sup> **October** between 7.00pm and 7.30pm. They will both be held in the Sacristy at **Our Lady of Peace Church**. Parents will need to complete an enrolment form which will be available on the enrolment date. The maximum amount of children we can take is 88, if we reach that number by Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> November which will be the deadline date for any enrolments, then any latecomers will have to wait until 2020. If your child was Baptised in another Parish, you will need to bring with you a copy of the child's Baptism certificate: if you cannot find it, you will need to contact the Parish where your child was Baptised and obtain it before the enrolment meeting.
