You light up our hearts with your love so we can see the way.


Alleluia, alleluia

Alleluia, alleluia


A reading from the holy Gospel according to John

Response: Glory to you, O Lord




Gospel John 13:31-35

If you live by this rule, other people will see your goodness and love, and they will know that you are my disciples.
