Gunnersbury Park Museum – Victorian Classroom Experience

As part of our learning in history, Year 5 will be visiting Gunnersbury Park Museum where they will experience life in a Victorian classroom. In order for them to enter into the spirit of the day, the museum request that the children dress up as Victorian school children.

The following clothing will be suitable:

Boys

Dark trousers tucked into knee length dark socks

School shoes

Plain long sleeved shirts

Waistcoat/neckerchiefs/plain scarves

Caps if possible

Girls

Hair styled off their faces

Long hair plaited but not in buns

Wear plain ribbons

Knee length socks

Calf or long skirts or dark dresses

Long or short sleeved blouses

It is not possible for all three classes to visit the museum on the same day, due to lack of space.

Therefore the classes will attend on the following days:

Class 5SS – Wednesday 16th January 2019

Class 5KD – Wednesday 16th January 2019

Class 5RR – Friday 18th January 2019

Please ensure that on the relevant day, your child comes to school dressed as a Victorian schoolchild.

Please also provide your child with a warm coat in case of inclement weather. A packed lunch in a named carrier bag will also be needed. No fizzy drinks will be allowed. There will be an opportunity for the children to purchase small souvenir items from the shop. If you would like your child to purchase items, please send your child with no more than £3 in a named envelope or purse. They must accept responsibility for any money they bring. The children will travel by coach to Gunnersbury Park Museum. They will leave at 9:15am approximately and return at approximately 3pm. A voluntary contribution of £14.50 is requested to cover the cost of the trip.
