

Nearby stood six very large water jars, and Jesus told the servants to fill them with water! 'Now pour some out and take it to the head waiter,' he said.


The water had been changed to wine and after tasting it, the head waiter went to the bridegroom and said, 'Sir, you have certainly saved the very best wine until last!'
