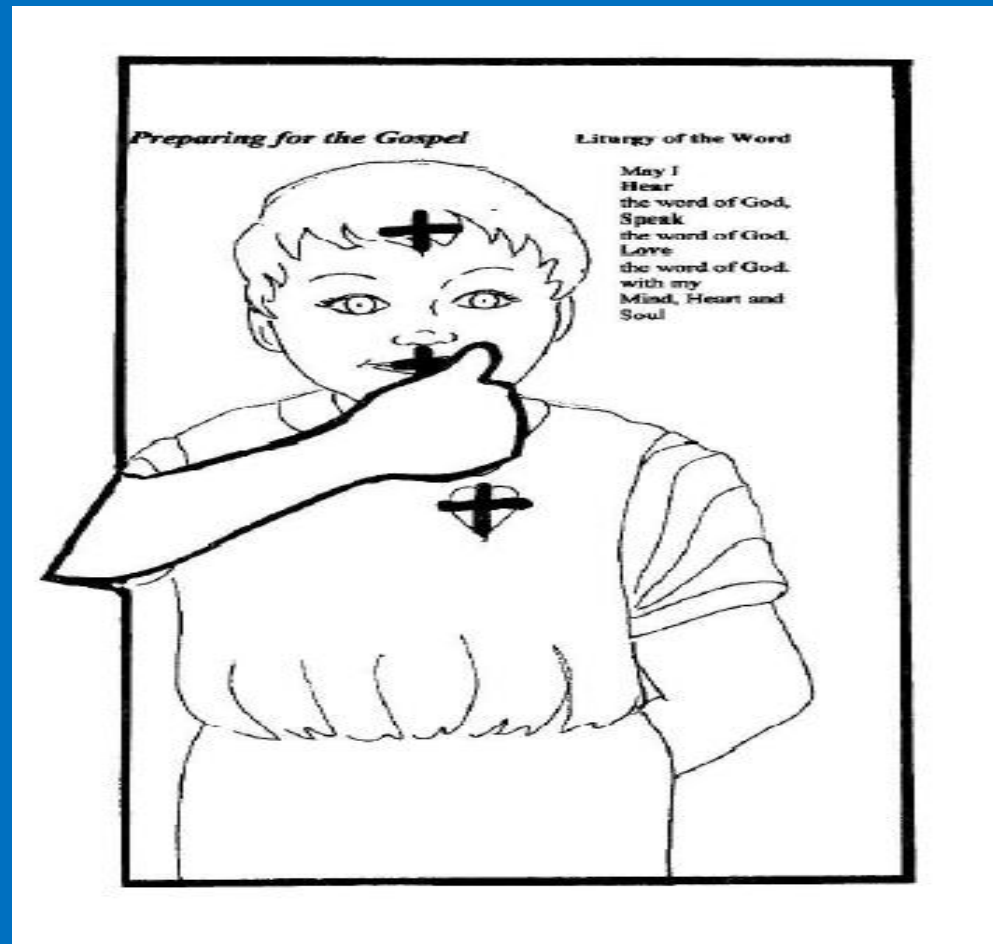

Gospel of the Lord

Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

Jesus chose seventy-two disciples and sent them out in pairs to all the towns and villages he would visit saying, 'Take nothing with you, and wherever you are welcomed, make the first words you speak, 'Peace be with you'. Stay if you are invited to, and eat and drink whatever you are given. Cure the sick and share the Good News of God's love with everyone. If you find people unfriendly or unkind, leave them and their village and go elsewhere.'

Soon the disciples returned and told Jesus about the marvellous things they had seen and done. Jesus said to them. 'Be happy indeed because your names are written in heaven.'

Reflection- hot seating

Question: Why did you (Jesus) send seventy-two disciples out to visit the surrounding towns and villages?

Answer: (Jesus) I needed help to take the message of God's love to people throughout the world. I sent my disciples out to prepare the people and let them know about the Good News and to bring God into their lives.

Question: What were the first words the Disciples needed to say?

Answer: (Jesus) 'Peace be with you.' (Jesus) I wanted my disciples to offer their peace and love so that the people they met would know they had nothing to fear. By sending out all of disciples in this way many more people will hear the message from God.

Ask the children as disciples, how would they spread the Good News about God's Peace and Love? Discuss in pairs
