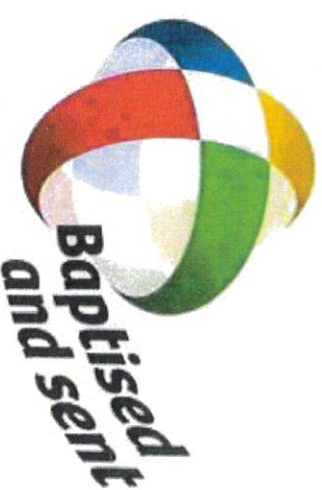

**Our Catholic Schools' Week  
7 - 13 October 2019**

Pope Francis has declared October 2019 to be an Extraordinary Month of Mission. This special month of prayer and action calls us to renew our missionary commitment to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with all peoples. We are called to be witnesses to Jesus, to his love and mercy for all people (c.f. missio.org.uk).

Since our Diocesan Catholic Schools' Week falls within this month we are taking Pope Francis' call to mission as our theme. We are given an opportunity during this week to continue to foster, build up and enhance relationships between our parishes, schools and homes for the good of all. God calls us together as a community, a family, a people. He calls us together to know his love and share his love with others. **Pope Francis has asked us to reflect on 4 themes in particular:**

1. A personal encounter with Jesus Christ living in his Church.
2. The witness of missionary saints and martyrs.
3. Missionary charity as a commitment to support the Church's missionary activity and communities too poor to support themselves, through Missio.
4. How we train and form ourselves for reaching out to others with the Good News of Jesus Christ.
