#### Maths for Lenten 1

#### **Number: Addition and subtraction**

Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20

Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.

Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.

Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as  $7 = \square -9$ 

#### Number: Place Value within 50/ Multiples of 2,5,10

Count to 50 forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any number.

Count, read and write numbers to 50 in numerals.

Given a number, identify one more or one less.

Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least. Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.

#### Handwriting

We teach cursive writing in year 1 and use a very good website. This website is called teachhandwriting.co.uk and below are some instructions for you regarding this website, so that you can see what we are doing at school.

We would suggest doing handwriting little and often each day, we usually do 10 mins in the morning and 10 mins in the afternoon, as well as the writing in any lesson that day. Handwriting takes time to master and there are going to be days that are better than others. This website also offers advice for parents on a range of topics relating to handwriting so it is definitely worth having a look at it.

When we do handwriting at school, we have the "animation" of the letter we want the children to write playing on the board whilst they are writing so that if they need a reminder of how it is written they can watch the board to see.

Below are the instructions on how to do this so that the children can practice at home.

#### Teachhandwriting.co.uk

- Click "resources" on the line under the main title
- Click "how to teach handwriting" (the second box down)
- Click "handwriting animations and worksheets" (first box down)
- Click "continuous cursive beginners"
- Click "choice 3"
  - On the screen where it has all the letters, on the top right of this screen is a circle saying "turn on loop" click this and then the letter you choose will play continuously for as long as you need.

Please support your child in practising continuous cursive handwriting as well as correct pencil grip and sitting position when writing.
