COVID - 19 CORONAVIRUS I am writing to give you an update from Bishop David, ordained and installed on Thursday as the new Bishop of Northampton Diocese, who we warmly welcome to our Diocese. The Catholic Bishops' Conference or England and Wales following government advice on how to contain the spread of COVID -19, and having consulted the Ordinaries of the Dioceses, has agreed that the cessation of public liturgies should begin from Friday evening 20th March 2020. Because of the situation the Church finds herself in, the obligation for the faithful to attend Holy Mass on a Sunday or Holy day of Obligation is removed, until further notice. Perhaps you could join in Spirit as the Masses are offered for you and make a Spiritual Communion. There is live streaming service from the Cathedral in Northampton https://northamptondiocese.org/live/ which you may wish to follow or follow Masses on EWTN and other TV Channels. More than ever, this is a time for all us all to look after each other. As a matter of duty, please phone up and check on one another. Let us continue to support and pray for one another. SVP and other charitable arms of the Church would need to continue their ministries of reaching out to the vulnerable. Leaders of groups in the Parish should also endeavour to reach out to their members. Strict hygiene protocols should be maintained, especially when distribution of goods and visits are involved. Our response to the virus There is a need to set up a Parish response team and I will welcome volunteers. Should any Parishioner be directly affected by the virus and need support, please ring or email the Parish office. Particular directives will be given about Holy Week and Sacred Triduum in due course. We will continue to keep you updated, and thank you for your continued support at this time.
