Place Value:

- Counting to ten, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. Counting, reading and writing numbers to 10 in numerals and words.
- Given a number, identifying one more or one less.
- Identifying and representing numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
