SLOUGH FOODBANK Free 6 x 2.5 hour sessions cooking and budgeting course - **STARTS** Monday, 19th February Slough Foodbank is running a free six week cooking/ budgeting course (Eat Well Spend Less) to show how to make nutritious food on a tight budget. Sessions are once a week for two and a half hours. The course demonstrates and allows participants to practise, making home-made meals, as well as giving practical advice and hand-outs about how to plan weekly menus and avoid spending more money on food than you need to. The course is very interactive and the participants can take home the food that they make in the classroom. All ingredients are provided free of charge. The course would benefit people who are feeling under the pressure of increasing food costs, but who may lack confidence in cooking for themselves and their families.
