We will be holding our first Parents Consultation Evening for those parents who have a child with SEN. This will be held on **Tuesday 26th September** and appointments will be available with your child's class teacher between 3.30 to 5pm. These appointments will be 10-15 minutes long and go through your child's <u>new</u> Individual Provision Map (IPM) for this term. It is important that you book and attend the appointment chosen so that your child's IPM is discussed and signed by all parties before their interventions can begin. <u>Your child's class teacher will approach you next week with a paper register sign up sheet for you to pick a time slot.</u> During the appointment you will also receive the latest copy of our school's SEN Policy and a SEN Questionnaire, which we would be grateful if you could return to the school office by Friday 29th September. Your opinions and feedback really do matter. We look forward to seeing you there.
