- She has now opened many schools around the world so girls can get an education.



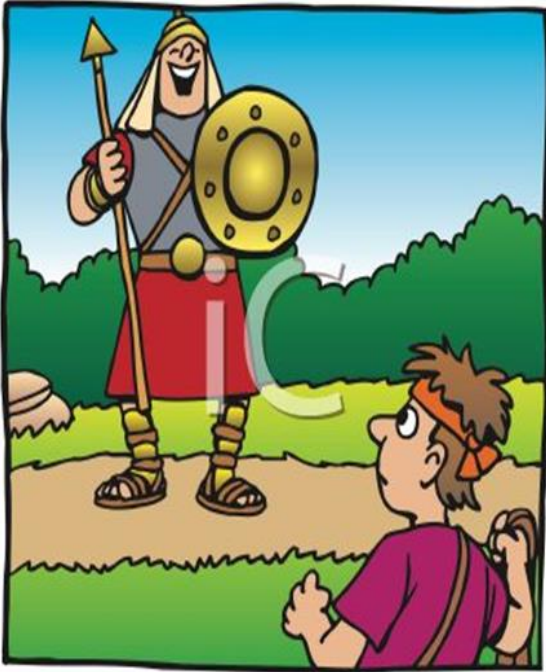
# Malala Yousafzai
