Please see below a message from Jo McGovern from Priory School.

As you will be aware, building work has begun on the school grounds for the new Resource building. We have worked really hard with the contractors and Slough Borough Council, to try to minimise the disruption to our parents but I know that it has not gone as smoothly this week as we had hoped. With that in mind, from Monday, we will put the following measures into place in conjunction with Morgan Sindall, the contractors:

- 1. There will be access into the school from a gate near the Children's Centre building to try and alleviate the bottleneck which is happening around the Year 1 area. The contractors are going to lay matting across the field which will help wheelchair/pushchair access.*
- 2. There will be signage for pedestrians which will hopefully help improve the flow of people around the car park while keeping them safe.*
