Strategic Vision	
Anne Bishop (parent governor) came along to the meeting to get some ideas for the	
Strategic Vision from the parent reps. She explained she needs at least 3 ideas of	
how they felt the vision of the school will be in the future. The ideas needed to be

It was asked if the SDP was on the website, Lisa T said that the two front pages	
which show the strategic vision were on the website as some information in the SDP	
was sensitive. The SDP is completed on a 3 year cycle but is a dynamic document	
that is reviewed and updated every year.

Parm said that Sandeep (ex treasurer of PTA) had informed her that there was money left over from the PTA fundraising and the parent reps suggested that a Bike shed should be purchased. Lisa T said that Marcel Devereux (foundation governor) is currently trying to secure grants and sponsorships for the school via external companies on the trading estate.

The fundraising should be put on the website so parents know what they school is raising money for. Parents would engage more if they know what they are fundraising for. LT to pick up with SLT	LT
Lisa T apologised that there was no representation from the school at the Donkey Derby.	

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Year 3 teaching concerns – Lisa T said that if there are no teachers to cover the class, supply teachers would be used. It was also asked if LSA's take the class, Lisa T said no only HLTA's or maybe for PPA time. The LSA's do supply the pastoral side to the school. The reps said they were very concerned regarding Year 3, Lisa T suggested that they talk to their class teacher initially to voice their concerns. The school has invested lots of time in recruitment and the school has a good reputation of teaching. There have been a lot of applications for vacancies, but the school need to make sure they have the quality and high standards and so is careful in the teachers it employs to ensure we have the right teachers for the school in the long term.	
An events page needs to be set up on the website, showing what has been happening in the school i.e. Year 6 Production, sports day and Mass. Lisa T will talk to Chris Cullane and Nick Stopps.	LT
