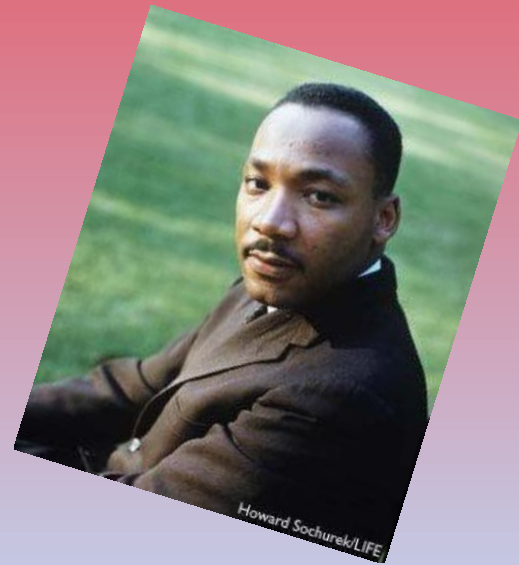
Our world with diversity

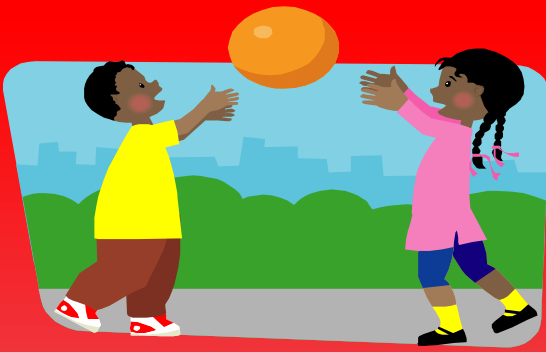


A world with DIVERSITY is much more interesting...



Over 50 years ago, an American Baptist Minister called Martin Luther King had a dream. He was a very special man.





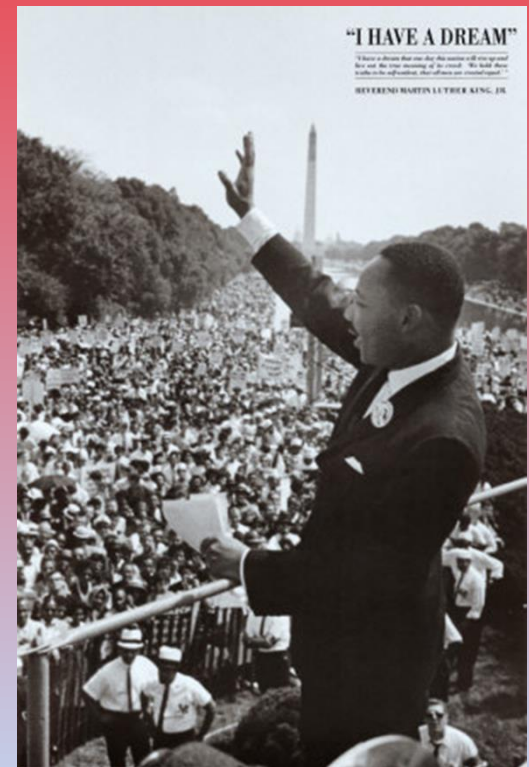
There were no white children at Martin's school. The law said that children with different skin colours could not go to the same school.

to him speak.



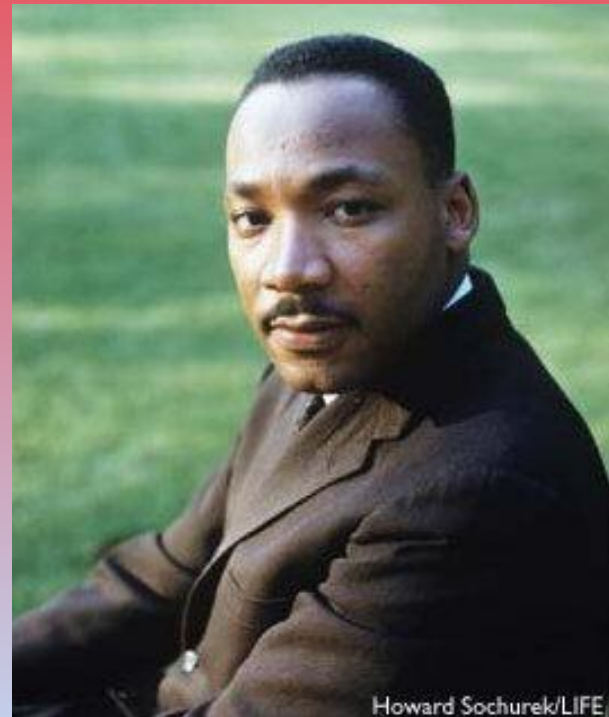
'I have a dream that one day little black boys and black girls will be able to join hands with little white boys and white girls as brothers and sisters.'

and agreed with him.


Martin changed many people's minds
