### Year 2 FairyTale Ball

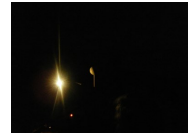
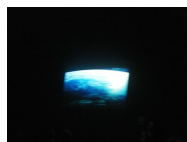


