




Gospel Mark 8:27-35

- One day while Jesus and his disciples were walking along, he asked them, 'Who do people think I am?'
- Some say that you are John the Baptist or Elijah or a prophet sent by God,' they answered. Then Jesus asked them, 'Who do you think I am?'
- It was Simon Peter who spoke up and said, 'You are Christ, the Son of God.'
- After this, Jesus began to tell them how he would suffer and die, but would rise again after three days. Simon Peter argued with him, 'Lord, we must not go to Jerusalem. These things must never happen!' Jesus said to him, Peter we must do things God's way, even through it will not be easy.'


The Gospel of the Lord-Mark 8:27-35

It was Simon Peter who spoke up and said, 'You are Christ, the Son of God.'



 Some people confused Jesus with John the Baptist. Some people heard Jesus preaching and thought he was a prophet. To others he was simply the son of Joseph and Mary. Jesus appeared differently to different people.

 Simon Peter, one of the apostles recognised who Jesus really was, he said 'You are the Christ, the Son of God.' Over time, all of the apostles had grown to know and love Jesus. On several occasions they had seen Jesus perform miracles which were only possible through the power of God. We spoke about this last week when Jesus cured the deaf man.

- When Simon Peter got angry when he heard that Jesus would suffer and die in Jerusalem, he wanted to save him and protect him from harm.
- Jesus told him that it was more important to follow God's way than the way we might choose, even though sometimes this can mean putting up with difficult times.

 The Gospel today tells us that Jesus is the Son of God. We are all called to follow him like Simon Peter, but Jesus warns us that this will always be easy. Just as he carried the cross for us before his death and resurrection, we will all have our own crosses or difficulties to bear in life. Our reward for this will be to share everlasting life with Jesus Christ. We know that Jesus is the Son of God and the saviour of the world. His love for us is unending and he loves us all.
