




Our Lady of Peace School

Glory to God, Glory to God, Glory to God in the highest And on earth, peace on earth, Peace to people of goodwill



Gospel Acclamation



Response: Glory to you, O Lord






Gospel Matthew- 3:13-17

When John saw Jesus in the distance walking towards him, he said to the crowds, "Look, there is Jesus the lamb of God. He is the special one sent by God whom I have told you about. I saw the Holy Spirit, hovering like a dove, coming down from Heaven and settling on Him. He is the one you must follow now, for he will baptise you not just with water, but with the Spirit of God"

Reflection 1

- What sign did God send so that John would know that Jesus was the chosen?
- John had been preparing the people but what else did God want him to do?

Reflection 2

- John called Jesus the "Lamb of God" because He would meekly sacrifice His life for us.
- John's work was coming to an end he had prepared the people to listen to Jesus and His message.
- John pointed Jesus out as the chosen one, the Son of God, and told the people to follow Him.

Reflection 3

Can anyone remember another occasion when the Spirit appeared, not as a dove, but in another way?

At Pentecost, when the disciples were hidden away in a room after the death of Jesus, the Spirit appeared as flickering flames, which came to rest on each of them and the room was filled with the sound of rushing wind. Certainly, He does not always appear as a dove!

Help us not to be afraid, help us to remember that God will always love you.

As a father loves his child, he will always love you.

Turn back to him and know God's love lasts forever.

When we see a dove, help us to remember that your spirit is with us in all that we do, helping to guide and protect us always.
