We love to celebrate good attendance at Our Lady of Peace Catholic and Nursery School and have introduced different incentives to improve attendance in the school.

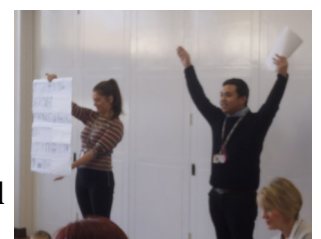


