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As Parent(s)/Guardian(s) I/we will:

- Support the spiritual life at Our Lady of Peace Catholic Primary and Nursery School and Church.
- Ensure that my child goes to school regularly, on time (8:55am), is properly equipped and dressed in school uniform.
- Provide a letter of explanation if my child is absent.
- Ensure that suitable and safe arrangements are made for collecting my child at the end of the day (3:15pm). If your child goes home alone, please inform the school in writing.
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work, behaviour or welfare.
- Support my child in their homework.
- Attend parent meetings and discussions about my child's progress.
- Endeavour to adhere to schools' holidays in view of the DfES's ruling that holidays during term time are not a right and permission must be granted in advance from the Headteacher.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour.
- Keep the school informed about where I/we may be contacted in an emergency and keep contact numbers up-to-date.
