Mother's Day	Understanding the world	Story Bags	Healthy Eating
The children would like to invite their Mum's to come in and listen to the children sing their special Mother's Day song. This will happen on Monday 1 st April 2019 at 11.30am for parents of morning children and 3pm for parents of afternoon and all day parents. <u>Safety</u> Please ensure that when dropping off and picking up, you keep your child close to you at all times, ensuring their safety in the car park and surrounding areas. Thank you.	The children loved sowing their own seed in group time. The children have been talking about what they need to do in order for their seed to grow. The children now know that their seed needs light, nutrients from the soil, water, air and space. Over the next couple of weeks the children will be looking after their seed and they will watch the changes take place. As their beanstalk starts to grow they will be using a ruler to measure how tall it is each day. At home: Talk about different plants and what they need to grow. Use a ruler to measure how tall different plants are and compare them.	Story Bags We hope you have all been enjoying the story bags each week. Please can we ask that before you return them to school that they are thoroughly checked to make sure all the books, games and puzzles are in the bag. If anything is missing from the bag please let a member of staff know when you return it. Unfortunately we have had story bags returned to school with missing pieces including pages from books and puzzle pieces. They are a wonderful resource that we have invested in for everyone to share. Please look after them.	We encourage the children to understand good practices with regards to healthy eating and hygiene. The children are aware they need to wash their hands before they eat. We have talked about germs and how they are spread. We will be talking about different types of food and whether they are healthy or unhealthy. We will be listening to the story 'Supertato'. The children will be designing their own superhero vegetable using real vegetables. At home: Talk about the different foods you see in the supermarket. Do you think they are healthy or unhealthy? What healthy foods do you enjoy? What food would you like to try?
