Children, for this brain builder we would like you to create a project linked to our current topic , The Romans. We are learning about the Roman way of life.

You could research the following:

- **Why did the Romans come to Britain?**
- **Roman leisure time/ entertainment**
- **The Roman Army**
- **Roman homes and food**

Remember to be creative and have fun!

Written multiplication and division: Multiply numbers between 10 and 25 by 1-digit numbers using the grid method; divide multiples of 10 by 1-digit numbers using known times tables facts; see the relation between multiplication and division

Money: Identify £ and p symbols and count in 1 p, 2 p, 5 p and 10 p coins; use related facts to count in 20 p coins.

Statistics: tally charts as a systematic method of recording data.

Fractions: Identify $\frac{1}{2}$ s, $\frac{1}{3}$ s, $\frac{1}{4}$ s, $\frac{1}{6}$ s, and $\frac{1}{8}$ s; realise how many of each make a whole; find equivalent fractions; place fractions on a 0 to 1 line; find fractions of amounts

Measurement: Length and perimeter measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/ cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml). Measure the perimeter of simple 2D shapes.

Problem Solving: Within each of the strands above, the children will continue to develop their problem solving skills.

Log-in to your 'My Maths' account and, each week, complete any activities provided.
