Open the Box!

- Have a box with a lid. Make a big show of wondering what's inside it. Be very scared. Each time you go to open it, you imagine it might be a spider or a poisonous snake or something hideous lying in wait quietly to grab you by the throat as soon as the lid opens...
- Say: But I've got a choice, haven't I? I can choose to leave the box shut that would be easy or I can choose to open it that would be hard.

 End up not daring to open the box but putting it on one side.

 Ask if anyone has ever felt scared of something. Get some ideas be sensitive as fears are very real. Perhaps you could talk about something you were scared of when you were little.
- Say: If I want to open the box but I daren't, I need a bit of courage to help me do what I want to do. I need something to make me a bit braver.
- You all were told about the story of David and Goliath last week. David was very small, but when he was faced with a big danger, he chose to be brave and do the right thing, not an easy thing. He didn't choose to run away from it. Perhaps when we're faced with something dangerous or painful, we can remember David and Goliath and the way God helped David to do something wonderful all David had to do was be a little bit brave
- Return to your box. Say: I can choose not leave the box shut, which doesn't take any courage at all. Or I can choose to open it, which means I need to have a bit of courage. What do you think I should do?
 - End up being brave enough to open the box and find something nice inside: a bar of chocolate would be very pleasant. Say: thanks to my bravery, the staffroom now has a nice box of chocolates/Biscuits to share.
