## Healthy Lunchboxes

We would like to remind parents about ensuring that they provide their child with a healthy packed lunch. According to NHS choices, a balanced lunchbox should contain: starchy foods like bread, rice, potatoes or pasta; protein foods like meat, fish, eggs or beans; a dairy item such as cheese or yoghurt; vegetables or salad and a portion of fruit. If necessary you could include one small chocolate biscuit such as a Kit Kat or similar and dried fruit snacks.

However, please remember that even if fruit snacks are 100% fruit, they are still considered 'processed' and will not have the nutritional value of fresh fruit.
