Catholic Life and Religious Education




Religious Education Curriculum

At Our Lady of Peace, follow the new Religious Education Directory which outlines the curriculum that all Catholic Schools in England have to follow.

The curriculum is split into 6 branches, one for each half term. This half term our branch is called 'Galilee to Jerusalem'.

In this branch, pupils explore the ministry of Jesus as they journey symbolically from Galilee to Jerusalem, deepening their understanding of who Jesus is and how he reveals God to the world. They learn that Jesus, the Word of God, makes the Father known through his parables, encounters, miracles, and teachings. Through these Gospel accounts, pupils come to recognise the key moments of Jesus' public ministry and the significance of his message for Christians today.



The Liturgical Year

This year, we are developing the children's understanding of the Liturgical Year. At present we are in ordinary time and this links well with our Galilee to Jerusalem branch in RE as during this season, we hear about Jesus making God the Father known to his followers.

The colour for this season is Green which is a symbol for hope and growth.




